My name is Pedro and at the age of twelve, I was out of my home and living on the streets, jails, and institutions. I have lived a life of violence and abuse on every level. In my teenage years I became a prison gang member, and since then I have spent the past 30 years in and out of jails and prisons.

In 2006, I was diagnosed with type 2 Aggressive non-Hodgkin's lymphoma of the superior vena cava. Treatment included radiation, chemotherapy, medication and multiple surgeries. Glory to God, I'm in remission.

In 2014, I committed the cowardly and violent act of robbery with the use of a firearm.

Hatred from family, friends, and society was rekindled. Two months later, in a state of hopelessness I submitted, accepted, and received Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. I'm a non-denominational Christian with interests in "deliverance" (healing, rebuking) and

drug and alcohol counseling from a Christian perspective (I do have degrees).

I'm a single father, I have an eight year old beautiful daughter

I do have a hopeful opportunity of being released next year, through potential new law (Assembly Bill 1310)

If released I will be caring for my elderly mother
